

ARKANSAS STATE CLAIMS COMMISSION

May 2019 Minutes

On May 16, 2019, the Arkansas State Claims Commission (the “Claims Commission”) held hearings in the Claims Commission Hearing Room, 101 East Capitol Avenue, Suite 410, Little Rock, Arkansas.

Troynetta Jefferson v. Arkansas Department of Transportation, Claim No. 190570. Claimant filed her claim seeking \$2,950.48 in compensation for damage to her vehicle caused by a pothole. Claimant failed to appear at the hearing. Trella A. Sparks appeared on behalf of Respondent. The Claims Commission GRANTED Respondent’s oral motion to dismiss for Claimant’s failure to prosecute her claim and DISMISSED Claimant’s claim.

Randy Mauldin and Steve Mauldin Trust v. Arkansas State Highway Commission, Claim No. 181051. Claimants filed a motion for reconsideration after the Claims Commission denied and dismissed Claimants’ claim as barred by the statute of limitations. After the motion for reconsideration was fully briefed, the Claims Commission set the motion for hearing. At the hearing, Beau Wilcox represented Claimants. Trella A. Sparks appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon the pleadings and argument of the parties, the Claims Commission DENIED Claimants’ motion for reconsideration.

Arkansas Home Health Providers–III, LLC, et al. v. Arkansas Department of Human Services, Claim No. 190018. Claimants filed the instant claim seeking \$257,952.13 in damages related to Medicaid reimbursements. Respondent filed a motion to dismiss based upon a lack of jurisdiction of the Claims Commission to consider this claim. After the motion was fully briefed, the Claims Commission set the motion for hearing. At the hearing, Aaron Heffington represented Claimants. Trevor Townsend appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon the pleadings and the argument of the parties, the Claims Commission GRANTED the motion and DISMISSED Claimants’ claim.

This completed all of the business on the May 2019 Claims Commission docket. There were no claims set for hearing on May 17, 2019.
