ARKANSAS STATE CLAIMS COMMISSION

April 2024 Minutes

The Arkansas State Claims Commission (the "Commission") held hearings on April 12, 2024, via Zoom.

The following members of the Commission were present:

- 1. Willie Jones v. Arkansas Division of Correction, Claim No. 211057. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages related to his allegation that Respondent did not honor his "low tier/no stairs" medical script which led to Claimant being injured when he fell on stairs. At the hearing on the claim, Claimant appeared pro se, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon a review of the claim file, the witness testimony and evidence presented, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission dismissed the claim.
- **2.** Bart Woodard v. Arkansas Division of Correction, Claim No. 221169. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages related Respondent's alleged omissions that resulted in another inmate raping Claimant multiple times. At the hearing on the claim, Claimant appeared pro se, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon a review of the claim file, the witness testimony and evidence presented, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission dismissed the claim.
- **3.** *Mark Bolton v. Ark. Div. of Correction*, Claim No. 210805. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages related to the loss of hobby craft materials. At the hearing on the claim, Claimant appeared *pro se*, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon a review of the claim file, the witness testimony and evidence presented, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission awarded Claimant \$500.00 in damages.
- **4.** *Shane Dimitt v. Arkansas Div. of Correction*, Claim No. 220405. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages relating to his allegation that Respondent's negligence and violation of policy resulted in Claimant being assaulted by another inmate. At the hearing on the claim, Claimant appeared *pro se*, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon a review of the claim file, the witness testimony and evidence presented, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission awarded Claimant \$1,500.00 in damages.
- **5.** Shane Dimitt v. Arkansas Div. of Correction, Claim No. 220889. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages relating to denial of yard call. At the hearing on the claim, Claimant appeared pro se, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon a review of the claim file, the witness testimony and evidence presented, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission dismissed the claim.
- **6.** Edward Ferguson v. Arkansas Div. of Correction, Claim No. 231284. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages related his allegation that he can no longer access his purchased music. At the hearing on Respondent's motion for summary judgment, Respondent's motion for sanctions and Claimant's motion to compel, Claimant appeared pro se, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon the review of claim file, the motions and responses, the argument of the parties, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission denied Respondent's motion for summary judgment, Respondent's motion for sanctions and Claimant's motion to compel.
- **7.** Anthony Lamar v. Arkansas Div. of Correction, Claim No. 220545. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages related his stimulus payments from the federal government. At the hearing on Respondent's motion for summary judgment, Respondent's motion to dismiss and Claimant's motion for summary judgment, Claimant appeared pro se, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon the review of claim file, the motions and responses, the argument of the parties, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission

denied Respondent's motion for summary judgment, Respondent's motion to dismiss and Claimant's motion for summary judgment.

- **8.** *Jeremy Hawkins v. Arkansas Div. of Correction*, Claim No. 221028. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages related his stimulus payments from the federal government. At the hearing on Respondent's motion for summary judgment, Claimant appeared *pro se*, and Thomas Burns appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon the review of claim file, the motion and response, the argument of the parties, and the law of the State of Arkansas, the Commission dismissed the claim.
- **9.** *Michael MacKool v. Arkansas Div. of Correction*, Claim No. 221028. Claimant filed this claim seeking damages related his stimulus payments from the federal government. At the hearing on Respondent's motion for summary judgment and Claimant's motion to add exhibits and motion to amend his response to the motion for summary judgment, Claimant appeared *pro se*, and Courtney Wall appeared on behalf of Respondent. Based upon the review of claim file, the motions and responses, the argument of the parties, and the law of the State of Arkansas, dismissed the claim.
- **10.** (Other Agency Business) The Commission reviewed and approved the entry of proposed orders numbered A1–A32, B1–B22, and C1–C17 on the attached list without discussion.
